Accessible Luxury

The Zicasso traveler has a household income floor of \$200k and up. They fit into several segments that include working couples, retirees and near-retirees, families, multigenerational families and, significantly, friends



traveling together in small and large groups.

While we handle many trips priced over \$100k, the bulk of our travelers spend in the \$6000-\$8000 range per person, for an average trip duration of 13.5 days. As such we provide "accessible luxury" for our audiences with exceptional, memorable experiences.

Overview of Key Findings

Our detailed analysis of the evolving luxury travel landscape revealed key findings that highlight significant shifts in traveler preferences and behaviors for 2025. Data from Zicasso's extensive network of travelers and booking patterns shows luxury travelers are strategically adjusting their approach to create more meaningful and personalized moments.

• Front-loading summer travel has emerged as a defining trend for 2025, with May showing a remarkable 27.43% year-over-year growth in summer trip requests. This strategic shift reflects travelers' desire to avoid peak-season crowds and extreme heat while securing preferential access to sought-after accommodations and activities.

- Overall spending on luxury travel continues to rise substantially, with the average trip cost increasing 23.5% year-over-year. This significant growth outpaces inflation and demonstrates strong confidence in the luxury travel sector despite broader economic considerations.
- Celebration focused travel continues to grow, with diverse traveler demographics seeking excursions that balance adventure with relaxation. The complex needs of these groups present both challenges and opportunities for creating truly exceptional travel moments.
- Celebration travel is driving destination choices for luxury travelers, with destinations like Indonesia, Costa Rica, and Greece emerging as premier locations for honeymoons, anniversaries, and milestone birthdays. These travelers seek unparalleled privacy, bespoke cultural connections, and exclusive access beyond traditional luxury accommodations.
- **Destination preferences are evolving dramatically**, with established European favorites

maintaining dominance while destinations like Australia, Scotland, and South Africa experiencing surges in interest for summer travel. This reflects luxury travelers' expanding horizons and growing appetite for destinations offering unique cultural immersion opportunities.

Through our comprehensive analysis of booking patterns, we've uncovered key trends shaping the luxury travel landscape for Summer 2025, including how travelers are increasingly shifting toward early summer months, indicating a strategic move away from traditional peak periods.

May bookings currently represent 27.43% year-over-year growth as of our latest analysis, showing the strongest demand of any summer month with notable increases in Europe where some visitors are avoiding the busiest periods, and Southern 27.43% Hemisphere destinations where off-season bookings continue to rise. year-over-year growth



Zicasso 2025 Top 10 Destinations Full year 2025 top destinations based on bookings as of April 1







Zicasso's Top 10 Destinations for Summer 2025

<u>Italy remains the undisputed leader for luxury summer travel</u>, accounting for 18.4% of total summer trip requests with remarkable consistency and a healthy 14.7% growth compared to 2024. <u>Greece follows as the second most requested destination</u> with 10.9% of total requests, though showing a slight decline of 7.6% from last year while maintaining significant growth compared to 2023.

The most dramatic shifts appear outside traditional European strongholds, and while not in the top 10 list, **Australia experienced extraordinary year-over-year growth with a 119.19% increase**, making it the fastest-rising summer destination in our rankings. Similarly, Scotland (+73.9%) and South Africa on its own (+55.8%) show remarkable increases, signaling growing interest in these regions for unique cultural and wildlife opportunities.




Shifting Destination Interests for Summer

Travelers in 2025

Traditional European Dominance but with Changing Dynamics

The top five European destinations (Italy, Greece, France, Spain, and Portugal) collectively account for 38.3% of total trip requests, demonstrating Europe's enduring appeal for summer travelers. Italy's Jubilee and France's post-Olympic momentum are key factors reinforcing their positions as top destinations, even as other European hotspots face challenges.



While France shows a nearly 32.6% growth, Spain and Portugal have experienced declines (-17.5% and -10.2% respectively) for summer travel, suggesting traveler concerns around overtourism and extreme heat during peak months. However, Spain may also be seeing a seasonal shift rather than a drop in overall interest with flight data showing double-digit

increases in Spain-bound air travel for 2025.

Anecdotal insights suggest a seasonal shift: what were once considered shoulder months, particularly October and November, are now seeing sustained demand, with some locals even referring to this period as the country's "new summer season."





Rapidly Rising Destinations

Destination & Experience Diversity Captivates Luxury Travelers

- <u>Australia's 119.2% growth represents the most dramatic increase</u> in our rankings, signaling a resurgence in travel to Oceania in the Northern Hemisphere's summer.
- <u>Scotland's 73.9% increase reflects growing interest</u> in its distinctive cultural heritage, dramatic landscapes, and luxury castle excursions.
- <u>South Africa's 55.8% surge highlights</u> the rising appeal of safari engagements combined with cultural and culinary exploration.

Pop Culture Call-Out: The "Outlander Effect"


Scotland's remarkable 73.9% growth in summer travel requests could be influenced by the "Outlander Effect." Our data reveals Outlander-related keywords are the most frequently mentioned entertainment theme in trip requests for Summer 2025. This cultural phenomenon is driving travelers to explore Scotland's highlands, castles, and historical sites featured in the popular series, contributing to the country's 13.3% increase in single-country trips as visitors seek immersive, in-depth interactions with Outlander filming locations and historical settings.

Unexpected Changes

Destination Interest Changes

- Spain (-17.5%) and Croatia (-15.6%) show the steepest declines among European destinations, possibly due to concerns about summer crowds and anticipated heat. However, both destinations are seeing a growing preference for travel during traditionally quieter months later in the year.
- Germany (-16.3%) and Iceland (-13.1%) have also seen reduced interest compared to 2024.

Summer Travel in Winter: Seasonal Specialists

These locations offer travelers the unique opportunity to exchange cold weather for summer-like getaways in the Southern Hemisphere or tropical regions. Understanding these seasonality patterns can help travelers make strategic timing decisions and plan well in advance for destinations that provide summer impressions during typical winter months.






Italy

2025 Summer Travel Trends Conclusion

The 2025 Summer Travel Trends paint a picture of an evolving luxury travel landscape characterized by strategic adaptation, increasing personalization, and willingness to invest in premium tours, activities, adventures, and more.

Front-Loading Summer Travel - May bookings surged 27.4% as travelers strategically avoid peak season crowds and heat while securing premium activities earlier in summer.

- Celebration-Focused Destinations Indonesia (37.1%), Costa Rica (24.8%), and Greece (24.6%) emerge as premier locations for milestone celebrations, driving destination choices as travelers seek meaningful moments for special occasions.
- Destination Horizons Expanding While traditional European destinations remain dominant, destinations like Australia (+119.2%), Scotland (+73.9%), and South Africa (+55.8%) show extraordinary growth as travelers seek unique cultural connections.
